2. Awards for 2007 high school graduates, who will begin full-time under-graduate study in September, 2007.
3. The following documents must be submitted directly to the Scholarship Chairperson , Loggia Glen Cove #1016 Inc., P.O. Box 347, Glen Cove, N.Y. 11542, no later than May 5th.
  - a. Official transcript including first semester of senior year grades.
  - b. One letter of recommendation from a teacher or counselor.
  - c. A student essay summarizing educational and career goals, school and community service and the significance of your Italian heritage.
4. Candidates must have an average of 85% or above in academic grades.
5. Scholarships are available to any son or daughter of a lodge member in good standing with a minimum membership of two years.
6. Four scholarships will be given from the Lodge. One of these scholarship will be awarded in memory of Lisa Carrera. Each scholarship will be awarded in the amount of \$1,000 for one year. A check of \$500 will be issued for the fall and \$500 for the spring semester.
7. The Lorenzo Martone Family Perpetual Scholarship, Dr. & Mrs. Michael Cavuoti Scholarship and the Scholarship in memory of Marianne Crescimanno follow the same requirements from #1 to #6. The scholarship amount will be the same as above and based solely on high academic achievement.
