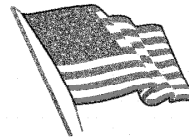
The Bocce party has been rescheduled to Sunday, April 20 at 4 p.m. here in the loggia. Please see the notice in this newsletter.

As always, I hope to see you all at our next meeting on April 2.      *Sempre Avanti,*

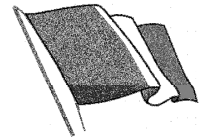
