Italy's World Cup triumph was its 4th time lifting the trophy in their history (1934, 1938, 1982 and 2006). Only Brazil has more titles with 5 championships to date. The Italian National Team was founded in 1898 and affiliated in 1905.

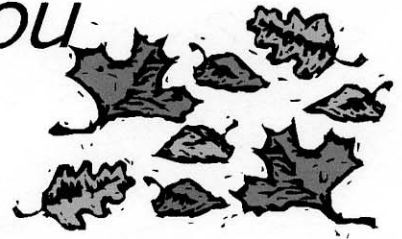

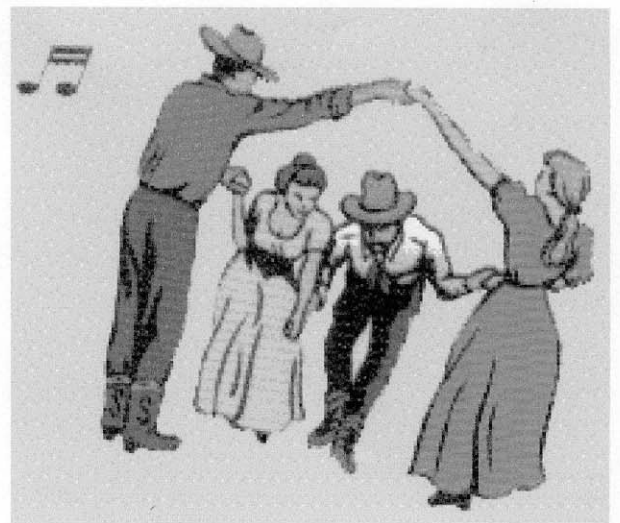
