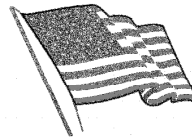
Finally, don’t forget our annual Ernest J. Pascucci Memorial Golf outing on August 11th (see flyer).

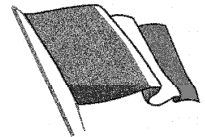
