### INGREDIENTS:

- 4 oz. spaghetti or vermicelli
- 1 jar (about 7 oz.) artichoke hearts in oil
- 1/2 small zucchini
- 1 carrot, shredded
- 2 oz. sliced salami, cut into strips
- 1 C. shredded mozzarella cheese
- 2 T. grated Parmesan cheese
- 2 T. vegetable oil
- 2 T. white wine vinegar
- 3/4 t. dry mustard
- 1/2 t. dried oregano, crushed
- 1/2 t. dried basil, crushed
- 1 clove garlic, crushed

## Italian Picnic Salad Recipe

Break pasta in half. Cook according to package directions, drain and set aside to cool 10 to 15 minutes.

Drain artichokes, reserving marinade; coarsely chop artichoke hearts. Quarter zucchini, then cut into slices.

In a large bowl, combine pasta, artichokes, zucchini, carrot, salami, mozzarella cheese and Parmesan cheese.

In screw-top jar, combine reserved artichoke marinade, vegetable oil, vinegar, mustard, oregano, basil and garlic; shake well. Pour dressing over pasta mixture and toss to coat. Transfer to a covered container. Chill before serving.

I am taking this opportunity to inform you on the current CSJ status and future projects of the NYS CSJ and District II.

I am proud to report that our CSJ Liaisons in our district are tireless involved and hard working on all the good and positive projects we are having. Soon a new poster of Italian American Writers will be ready to be printed and distributed.

The NYS CSJ Solidarity Breakfast with the Metro North B'nai B'rith International, was very good and well attended. We honored two members of the Holocaust Memorial Committee: Vincent Marmorale and our beloved Walter Wolff. The Lehman-La Guardia Award for Civic Achievement was presented to the honorees.

Sadly, Walter passed away few weeks after the event. He was 90 years old.

I am proud to report that the Bella Lingua CSJ District II Achievement Award Committee selected, from a group of 14 participants, two great students to receive a prestigious award of (\$ 500.00 cash, each) at our CSJ District II meeting on June 28, 2007. The two students selected are: Judy Schnieder from the Locust Valley High School, and Jennifer Rose Cerullo, from the Syosset High School. This award is given to two students who are studying the Italian Language for four years in high school and graduate with high marks.
