Protect your fig trees!!!

It's about to get cold out there and here are some handy tips to get your figs looking their best for next year. **First)** the best location for your tree is a near a south facing wall or solid fence. **Second)** Wrap with some insulating material. Choices can be **1. Carpet 2. Blankets 3. Layers of Canvas 4. Pink Fiberglass.** >>>

Did you know



All insulating material should extend from the ground to the top of the plant. This should be topped with a plastic sheet or large plastic bag in order to keep the insulation dry. Under no circumstances should the plastic contact the tree itself. *Mangia bene e vive sane.*
